- Funding is provided for socio-educationally accompanied projects with production school-oriented approaches as a low-threshold offer of vocational orientation and vocational preparation as well as
- to support the transition to training or further vocational preparation projects and to support the transition to employment.

### Conditions

Type of funding Proportionate funding (non-repayable grant)

Amount up to 90 % of eligible expenses

On the basis of standardised unit costs, lump sums are granted for

- Personnel costs
- Travel allowance
- Administrative costs
- Reimbursement of expenses
