Volltext	If you would like to report "litter", please contact the lower waste authority in your town or district. "Wild waste" is waste that is illegally deposited in the open countryside, in forests or along streams and in public places outside the designated waste containers. This can include, for example, household and bulky waste, building rubble, construction site waste, car wrecks, but also excess excavated soil (loose and solid rock excavated or removed during construction work). It is also "wild waste" if the waste has been covered with soil. The dumping of "wild waste" is prohibited and constitutes an administrative offense. It can be punished with a fine. If the person responsible for the "wild waste" can be identified, they will be charged for the disposal costs incurred. Special instructions that apply to the place where you dispose of the waste: you have found the litter, enter the town or zip code in the search field above this text. After selecting the location, the contact details of the responsible office will be displayed.

"Wild waste" is waste that is illegally deposited in the open countryside, in forests or along streams, in public places, on the roadside or in front of houses and gardens outside the designated waste containers. The dumping of "wild waste" is prohibited and constitutes an administrative offense. A fine may be imposed.
Ansprechpunkt	You can reach the contact persons of the lower waste authorities via the websites of your city or district.
Zuständige Stelle	In the municipal area, responsibility generally lies with the local police authorities of the towns and municipalities. In the case of country roads, federal roads or federal highways, the road authorities are responsible for the removal of illegal waste deposits. In the state forest, the forestry authority is responsible for the removal of illegal waste deposits. After selecting the location where you have found the waste deposit, you will be shown the responsible authority.
