Volltext	If you are a German citizen living abroad, you can still vote in the European elections. To do so, you must apply to be entered in the electoral register.

Verfahrensablauf As a German national living abroad, you can register in
the electoral roll for the European elections as follows register:
 You submit an application in accordance with Annex 2 of the European Election Regulations to the last municipality in which you had a residence or otherwise habitually resided before moving abroad. If you have never lived in Germany, the application must be submitted to the Berlin Mitte district office. The authority will decide on the application and at the same time send out postal voting documents or a rejection notice
