Teaser	Are you entitled to vote and would like to vote in a different polling station or take part in the election by postal vote? Then you must apply for a polling card.
Volltext	If you have received a polling card but cannot or do not wish to vote in your electoral district on election day,

	you can apply for postal voting documents. These contain the polling card.
	The polling card will indicate where you can apply for postal voting documents.
	If you are unable to use the designated polling station due to a disability, you can also apply for a polling card.
	If you collect your polling card and postal voting documents in person from the city or municipal administration, you have the opportunity to cast your vote on the spot. The administration will ensure that you can mark your ballot paper unobserved and place it in the ballot paper envelope.
Erforderliche Unterlagen	<ul> <li>Provide personal data (name, date of birth, address)</li> <li>Written authorization if a third person is to submit the application for you or receive your documents</li> </ul>
Voraussetzungen	<ul> <li>You are eligible to vote in the relevant election and are entered in the electoral roll.</li> <li>If you are applying on behalf of another person: You must submit a written power of attorney.</li> </ul>
Kosten	There are no costs.
Verfahrensablauf	You can apply for your polling card as follows:
	<ul> <li>You go to the city or municipal administration in person and collect your polling card there,</li> <li>You submit a written application - use the form on the back of the election notification,</li> <li>You apply for the polling card electronically, if your city or municipality offers such a procedure (online application, e-mail),</li> <li>You ask a representative who has your written authorization to collect the documents for you.</li> </ul>
	It is not possible to apply by telephone.
	<ul> <li>for national elections, an information sheet on postal voting explaining how to vote by post</li> </ul>
	In Mecklenburg-Vorpommern, please use the form you received with your election notification if you are

	applying in writing.
Bearbeitungsdauer	1 - 8 Woche(n) If you send your application by post or email, it will take a few days from the time you submit your application until you receive your postal voting documents. If you apply for a polling card from abroad, this may take longer due to long postal delivery times. If you submit the application in person, you will usually receive the postal voting documents immediately.
Frist	You will receive your polling card at least 3 weeks before election day. If you have not received it in time, please contact your city or municipal administration. As a rule, you must have applied for a polling card no later than two days before election day at 6.00 pm. The postal voting documents must be received by the municipality by 6 p.m. on election day at the latest. If you have applied for a polling card but never received it, you can obtain a new polling card up to 12:00 noon on the day before election day. To do this, contact your city or municipal administration. For state and local elections in Mecklenburg-Vorpommern, you must generally apply for your polling card by 12.00 noon on the second day before the election.

Hinweise	If you are unable to cast your postal vote on your own due to a physical impairment or literacy problems, another person may help you. Your helper must  • be at least 16 years old and • confirm in lieu of an oath that the ballot paper has been marked in accordance with your declared wishes.
