Teaser	You can obtain a residence permit to look for a training place in order to carry out qualified vocational training if you meet certain requirements
Volltext	<p>You can obtain a residence permit for the purpose of looking for a training place if you would like to complete qualified vocational training in Germany but have not yet found a training place. Qualified vocational training exists if it is vocational training in a state-recognized or comparably regulated training occupation that lasts at least two years.</p> <p>The residence permit to look for a training place in order to carry out qualified vocational training is a temporary residence permit. It can be issued for a maximum of up to six months.</p>
Erforderliche Unterlagen	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Valid passport</li> <li>• Current biometric photo</li> <li>• Visa, if required</li> <li>• Proof of livelihood (e.g. declaration of commitment, blocked account at a bank, proof of parents' income or similar)</li> <li>• Tenancy agreement</li> <li>• Proof of your health insurance</li> <li>• Proof of German language skills at level B2</li> <li>• Proof of a corresponding school-leaving qualification</li> </ul>
Voraussetzungen	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• You have a recognized and valid passport or passport substitute and - if required for entry - an appropriate visa.</li> <li>• There is no interest in deporting you.</li> </ul>

## Sachverhalt

- Your stay does not jeopardize or impair the interests of the Federal Republic of Germany.
- You have not yet reached the age of 25.
- You have a school-leaving certificate that entitles you to enter a university or a degree from a German school abroad.
- You can provide proof of German language skills at level B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).
- Your livelihood is secured for the duration of your search for a training place.

## Kosten

Issuing a residence permit: EUR 100.00

Under certain conditions, a fee reduction or fee exemption may be possible.

## Verfahrensablauf

You must apply for a residence permit at the foreigners authority responsible for your place of residence. The procedure is as follows:

- Depending on the foreigners authority and your request, it may be possible to apply via the Internet. Find out whether your foreigners authority offers electronic application for a residence permit.
- If you can only apply in person, make an appointment with the immigration office. During the appointment, your application will be accepted and your supporting documents checked (bring these with you to the appointment). Your fingerprints will be taken for the production of an electronic residence permit (eAT card).
- In the case of an electronic application, the Immigration Office will contact you after receiving your online application to arrange an appointment at the Immigration Office if necessary. During the appointment, your documents will be checked (bring them with you to the appointment) and your fingerprints will be taken for the production of the electronic residence permit (eAT card).
- If your application is approved, the Foreigners' Registration Office will arrange for the eAT card to be issued.
- After about six to eight weeks, you can collect the eAT card from the immigration office.

Kurztext	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Residence permit for the purpose of training Issued to search for a training place in order to complete qualified vocational training</li> <li>• Foreigners who have not yet reached the age of 25 and wish to complete qualified vocational training in Germany but have not yet found a training position can obtain a residence permit for the purpose of seeking training.</li> <li>• They must have good German language skills at level B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR), be able to prove that they can support themselves and have a school-leaving qualification that entitles them to enter higher education or a qualification from a German school abroad.</li> <li>• The residence permit is a temporary residence title. It is issued for a maximum of up to six months.</li> <li>• Depending on the foreigners authority and your request, you can apply online or in person.</li> <li>• A fee is charged for the issue of the residence permit.</li> </ul>
