Teaser	If you would like to study in Germany but have not yet fulfilled the conditions for taking up your studies, you can obtain a residence permit for this purpose.

- you have been accepted to take part in a preparatory language course without having already been admitted by a higher education institution.
- you have been accepted by a company to complete an internship in preparation for your studies.

When deciding whether to issue your residence permit, the Foreigners' Registration Office may obtain opinions from the university or other institutions approved for training or further education on questions relating to the study requirements.

The residence permit for studying will be issued for a minimum of 1 year and a maximum of 2 years.

If you are participating in an EU or multilateral program with mobility measures, for example the ERASMUS+ program of the European Union, or if you are covered by an agreement between 2 or more higher education institutions, you will be granted a residence permit for at least 2 years.

As a rule, your livelihood and health insurance cover must be guaranteed for the duration of your stay.

The residence permit allows you to work up to 120 days or 240 half days per year. You can also take on a part-time student job.

If you have not yet reached the age of 18, your parents or legal guardians must agree to your stay in Germany.

Erforderliche Unterlagen

- Recognised and valid identity document (e.g. passport or passport substitute)
- Visa, if required for entry
- In the case of a previous stay in Germany: Current residence document (e.g. residence permit)
- Recent biometric photo in passport format (45 x 35 mm)
- Proof of conditional admission to studies, enrollment or admission to a preparatory language course or internship
- Proof of securing your livelihood (e.g. from your own

assets, payment of a security deposit into a blocked account, bank guarantee, declaration of commitment, scholarship, proof of receipt of benefits such as parents or child benefit, proof of parents' income or similar)

- Proof of health insurance coverage (for example, confirmation of health insurance coverage or insurance policy)
- In the case of conditional admission to the degree programme or enrolment, proof of the language skills required for the specific course of study may be required
- In the case of minors: consent of all persons with custody to the planned stay (declaration of consent); if the custodial parents are unable to submit the application jointly on behalf of their child, a written power of attorney from the absent parent is required; if only one parent has custody, the signature of that parent is sufficient

The documents and information must always be submitted in German. In individual cases, the Foreigners' Registration Office may require less or more proof.

- You have no right to be granted a residence permit. It

is at the discretion of the immigration authority to grant the residence permit.

- Make sure that your details are correct and complete so that your application can be processed without delay.

Rechtsbehelf

- An appeal against a negative decision of the Foreigners' Registration Office can be brought before the competent administrative court.
- A preliminary procedure (opposition) does not take place in Lower Saxony.
- Detailed information can be found in the rejection notice.

Kurztext

- Applying for a residence permit for conditional admission to study and part-time study
- "conditional admission" means that, for example, language courses, compulsory internships or attendance at a preparatory college are required before commencing studies
- The residence permit prior to commencing studies can be issued to fulfill certain conditions in Germany if you have been admitted to a state university, a state-recognized university or a comparable educational institution for full-time study, but the admission is linked to a condition that is not aimed at attending a preparatory course, for example proof of completion of a Bachelor's degree admission from a state university, a state-recognized university or a comparable educational institution for full-time study has been granted, but admission is subject to the condition that a preparatory college or a comparable institution is attended as a preparatory study measure admission has been granted by a state university, a state-recognized university or a comparable educational institution for part-time studies a commitment to a preparatory language course without the admission of a higher education institution you have been accepted by a company to complete an internship in preparation for your studies
- the permit can also be issued if you have not yet been admitted to a preparatory college or a comparable institution
- living expenses and health insurance cover must generally be secured for the duration of the stay

without recourse to public benefits

- the Aliens' Registration Office may obtain the opinion of the university or other institutions approved for training or further education on questions relating to the study requirements
- Residence permits are issued for at least 1 year
- in the case of participation in a union or multilateral program with mobility measures, for example the ERASMUS+ program of the European Union, or if an agreement between 2 or more higher education institutions applies to the applicant, the residence permit will be issued for at least 2 years
- if the applicant has not yet reached the age of 18, the persons entitled to personal care must consent to the stay in Germany
- the residence permit entitles the holder to work for up to 120 days or 240 half days per year. Student part-time employment can be pursued for an unlimited period of time
