If the birth is recorded in the electronic civil status register of a registry office in Brandenburg, it is also possible to obtain the birth certificate from any other Brandenburg registry office.

	 Your identity card or passport (if requested in writing: certified copy), in the case of application or collection by a representative: written authorization of the authorized person, his/her identity card or passport (original or





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	certified copy) and the identity card or passport of the representative, for other persons, where applicable, proof of their legal interest.

	Eligible applicants (minimum age: 16 years):
	 the person to whom the birth certificate refers the spouse or civil partner (within the meaning of the Registered Partnership Act) Ancestors and descendants of the data subject Siblings with a legitimate interest
	Other persons, including close relatives such as aunts and uncles, will only receive a document if they can credibly demonstrate a legal interest (for example, by means of a letter from the probate court).

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 Send an informal letter to the responsible registry office with a request to issue you a birth certificate. Your letter should include the following information: Surname, first name Date and place of birth Surname, first name of parents if known: registry office and notarization number
 Include a certified copy of your ID card or passport with the letter.
When you send the certificate, you will receive a fee notice.
Depending on the offer of the registry office, you can also submit the application online.

A birth certificate may also be issued on a multilingual form, in particular for use abroad (International Birth Certificate under the Convention of 8 September 1976 on the Issue of Multilingual Extracts from Civil Status Registers). You can use them abroad without translation. You can obtain an international birth certificate at the registry office that certified your birth.
