Volltext	<p>Further training for academic health professions, especially for doctors, is an important prerequisite for being allowed to practice the profession practically.</p> <p>During the training, you will learn the necessary skills and abilities for your future profession.</p> <p>Through the training you will receive your specialist, specialization, or additional title. If you successfully complete several further training courses, you may use all acquired titles side by side (e.g. FA for Pediatrics and Adolescent Medicine - focus on pediatric cardiology).</p> <p>The training is carried out exclusively by doctors who have been authorised by the Medical Association.</p> <p>The duration of the training depends on the respective course. In principle, you must complete the training full-time and full-time. However, exceptions are possible.</p> <p>As a doctor without specialist training, you are not allowed to work in all areas and institutions of medicine. In the past, doctors without specialist training were allowed to establish themselves as general practitioners or to work as contract doctors. This is no longer possible. However, you are likely to continue to work in a private practice, in emergencies</p>

<b>Erforderliche Unterlagen</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Logbook documenting the training</li> <li>• Application for recognition</li> <li>• Curriculum vitae</li> <li>• Certificates of further education as a certified copy (cf. § 9 Further Education Regulations of the LÄKB of 29.10.2005), proof of compliance with the guideline</li> <li>• Other evidence required by the continuing education regulations</li> <li>• Documentation of annual meetings</li> </ul>
<b>Voraussetzungen</b>	<p>For the recognition of the continuing education you must meet the following requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• You have successfully completed your studies.</li> <li>• As a doctor, you need your license to practice medicine.</li> <li>• You have successfully completed further training as a specialist or specialisation. The training is documented in the logbook.</li> <li>• You have passed the examination at the State Medical Association of the State of Brandenburg.</li> <li>• You are a member of the Brandenburg State Medical Association (during the recognition procedure and on the day of the examination).</li> </ul>
<b>Kosten</b>	Recognition of a designation with examination interview: 200,00 € according to the administrative fee schedule of the LÄKB
<b>Verfahrensablauf</b>	<p>As soon as you have received the license to practice medicine, you can start further training. All continuing education courses offered are announced by the Medical Association. During the training, you will acquire all the necessary skills and abilities. All completed courses are documented in a logbook.</p> <p>At the end of the training, you apply for admission to the examination at the Medical Association. You can only be admitted to an examination for the focus and receive recognition if you have already successfully completed specialist training.</p> <p>The Medical Association sets the date for examination. This is oral and lasts at least 30 minutes.</p>

	You will receive the certificate of recognition and may use the specialist, specialisation or additional title.
Bearbeitungsdauer	According to § 14 paragraph 1 sentence 1 WBO, the Medical Association sets the date for the examination, which takes place within a reasonable period of time, at the latest 6 months after admission.
Frist	There are no deadlines for applying for recognition.
