The distribution of training times among the members of these organizations should take into account the different needs of full-time and volunteer personnel.

Verfahrensablauf	The application must be submitted to the government of Upper Bavaria. The government of Upper Bavaria is also responsible for the execution (payments, verification of use, etc.) of the grant procedure.
