A certificate of origin provides information about the place of origin of a product. Erforderliche Unterlagen

Evidence of the origin of the goods. Proof of origin can be, for example: Self-declaration on the manufacture of the goods in your own company Certificates of origin from another IHK Certificates of origin Form A (from developing countries) Preferential movement certificates EUR Preferential declarations of origin according to format specifications from EU free trade agreements Supplier declarations according to VO (EU) 2015/2447 Please ask the IHK responsible for you which documents are specifically required in your case.

Voraussetzungen

You can prove the origin of the goods.

Kosten

Fee: 5 – 25 EUR

Verfahrensablauf

You can use an online procedure or a written procedure to apply for a certificate of origin or a certificate for a commercial document. Online procedure: Send an e-mail to the chamber of commerce responsible for you with the request to activate the online application. Complete the application electronically and send it to the IHK using the online application. The IHK checks the completeness and correctness of your information. The IHK may request additional information and documents from you to prove the correctness of the information contained in the application. After checking the information, the IHK certifies the certificate of origin or the commercial document by means of an electronic signature. The IHK then provides you with the certified document in the online application. You can print out the document if required. Written procedure: Fill out the application and sign it Submit the application either by post or on site at the ServiceCenter of your IHK. The IHK checks the completeness and correctness of your information. The IHK may request additional information and

	documents from you to prove the correctness of the information contained in the application. After checking the information, the IHK certifies the certificate of origin or the commercial document. The certified document will then be returned to you by post.
